

Minutes of the NH Wheelers Meeting For 25 June 2022

The June 2022 meeting of the NH Wheelers was called to order at 10:05 AM on 25 June 2022 by President Spencer Stickney at the Wild Duck Campground in Scarborough, Maine. 6 member families were present. Jim Belanger moved that we go to Woodmore for June 2023, second my Dennis Lortie and the motion carried.

Unfinished Business: None.

New Business: Armand moved, seconded by Jennifer, that we pay Dennis \$20 instead of \$10 for his supply of coffee and condiments at the campouts. Dennis objected. Jim spoke against this expense since others provide extras like a second drawing at times and hot dogs by Spencer and don't expect the be repaid. Motion voted down. Armand moved that we pay Dennis \$10 for the purchase of firewood at the last campout, Dennis seconded. Motion carried.

Announcements: There will be no Ice Cream social at the July campout. Meeting will be at 0930 instead of 10 AM. Volunteers are needed to help the organizers (Diana and Jane) with the games. Please contact one or both to let them know you will be helping.

Birthdays/Anniversaries: President Spencer read the names of folks with Birthdays and Anniversaries this month.

Other Business: There is a lot of New Business to be considered by all as the NH Good Sams organization is dis-banding. There was a meeting of all Chapter Presidents to discuss the outcome at which our President was unable to attend. Information after the meeting was conveyed to Jim Belanger from Dick Coderre, the NH Good Sam Treasurer, after Janice Murray brought the subject to Jim's attention. Good Sams International is going through major changes which remain in limbo at this time. There will no longer be Good Sam Ambassadors for each State, for example. It appears other States will continue as in the past but NH will not due to lack of volunteers for leadership and the demise of so many NH Chapters. The Wheelers will continue in operation but will no longer be associated with Good Sam. This means a revamp of our By-Laws and operating procedures which Jim Belanger will undertake in the following months. NH Good Sam treasury had enough funds to allocate \$1,000.00 to each remaining NH Chapter. This amount is not to be given to the Chapter's treasury but to a Charity of the Chapter's choosing. Discussion at our meeting resulted in the recommendation to donate \$500 each to Clear Path for Veterans and to Shriners Hospitals for Children. An alternate, if needed, was Veterans Count of NH. This information has been conveyed to Dick Coderre who will see that it is done with Credit given to Wheelers.

The raffle: The 50/50 raffle drawing got \$23 for the club and \$22 for Dave Allen, the winner.

Meeting adjourned at 10:37 AM after a motion by Dennis Lortie, seconded by Armand Pinard.
